Registration Policy

1. Introduction

The practice boundary has been reduced effective from June 2019:

2. Registration of New Patients

The practice will only be registering new patients within the new boundary area.

3. Patients in the Old Boundary

Patients registered with the practice in the old boundary area will not be affected by the change. Patients already registered will remain registered with the practice and will still be entitled to home visits. If a patient registered with the practice in the old boundary area should have a new household member live with them – this new patient can be registered with the practice and have the same care as the household including home visits.

4. Out of Area Patients (OOA)

The practice will not register any patients who live outside of the current practice boundary. This includes patients that are registered with the practice in the old/new boundary that move out of the new boundary area.
